

First RTFC Auction of 2013

Successful first RTFC auction of 2013

The first interactive RTFC auction of 2013 took place on Tuesday 15th January with almost 1 million RTFCs sold. The majority of these certificates related to year 5 and the average price achieved was 11p.

The interactive auction model has the attraction of facilitating greater price discovery and has received excellent feedback. As well as sellers being able to auction their RTFCs already issued by the DfT, they are now able to sell certificates to be issued at a later date and can also revise reserves, if necessary, during the auction. Buyers have the ability to offer prices to sellers lower than the set reserves, a bid and offer type approach.

As a buyer and to avoid any shortage of year 5 RTFCs the monthly auction provide an ideal platform for purchases and remember you can still maintain your anonymity and are not charged any fees.

The next scheduled auctions are **Tuesday 19th February and Tuesday 19th March 2013.**
